

The first face to face Steering Committee meeting of the Eco-TransH Project has taken place in Toulouse (France) on Friday the 15th of December, 2023, in occasion of the REGAL (Regional Agriculture Fair)



During this first steering committee, the Pyrenees Comminges Agricultural Campus, as leader of this Eco-transH project, invited several institutions and partners in person:

The FAO, the Ministry of Agriculture, the Massif of Pyrenees Commission, the Regional Directorate of Agriculture in Occitanie, Irqualim, the Haute Garonne Departmental Council, the LEGTA of Pamiers and representatives of the project partner countries: Mongolia, Greece, Italy, Romania, and Morocco.
